

## Water tourism

The location of the town on the Oder-Spree channel as well as on the river Oder does not only offer direct connection to the European network of waterways, but it offers also numerous opportunities for water tourism. In Fürstenberg the Oder-Spree channel branches off to the Berlin water bodies. This gives the best conditions for water sports fans of Berlin to explore the natural finish landscape of the river Oder up to the Baltic Sea.



What about a trip by ship in order to enjoy sunny days to the full? It is a must to explore the water-rich Land Brandenburg on a passenger ship. In addition to romantic, comfortable trips, a tour may also be quite exciting, because the trips pass remote areas with fascinating flora and fauna.



The Oder-Spree channel (OSK) connects the river Spree with the river Oder. The twin-shaft lock in Eisenhüttenstadt is a unique technical architectural monument and the last of four locks that have to be crossed on the way to the river Oder.

The complex had been built from 1925 to 1929 and consists of two adjoined locks. It bridges the height gap of 14 m.



In the town centre, the motor yacht club in Milenz- port can be called at by sport boaters. Permanent boating slips, sanitary facilities, accommodation facilities, water supply and sewage disposal, as well as fuelling in direct proximity up to bike rental are the concrete advantages of this complex.





The Eisenhüttenstadt rowers and canoeists have their base in the sporting facilities "Trockendock" and "Inselspitze".
